



2 次の英文は、中学生の広斗(Hiroto)と留学生のルーシー(Lucy)が交わしている会話である。次のアプリ(app) を参考にして英文を読み、下の問い(1)~(4)に答えよ。(8点) Lucy: Hi, Hiroto. What are you looking at? アプリ (app) Hiroto: Hi, Lucy. I'm looking at an app called "Wakaba" on my phone. (ア) Lucy: What is it? Lake Hiroto: This is an app made by Wakaba City. This app Wakaba introduces places for \*sightseeing in this city. Lucy: I see. Do you often use the app? Hiroto: Yes, example, I went to Lake Wakaba and Wakaba Temple last week after checking them on the app. That was fun. That's great. I also want to use the app, but I Lucy: Minato can't understand Japanese well. Station Hiroto: You can get the information in English on the app. I'll choose English for you now. Lucy: Thank you. I am happy that I can get the Wakaba River information in English on this app. My sister is going to come to Wakaba City from her country next month, but I don't know the places for sightseeing here. I have lived here 2 months. So, I want to use the app and walk around the city with her. Hiroto: What kind of place do you want to visit? Lucy: Well, I heard there is a famous \*railway in this city. Hiroto: It is Wakaba Railway. It was built about forty years ago, and trains on this railway run from Sakura Station to Kaede Station. There are fifteen other stations between the two stations. The trains run along the Wakaba River, so you can enjoy the \*scenery from the train. Lucy: You know a lot about the railway. Hiroto: I got the information about the railway on the app. We can listen to the \*audio guide. Lucy: I think it is a great app. My sister likes art, and I want to visit an art museum with her. Hiroto: Well, how about 3 Wakaba Art Museum? It is near Minato Station. Lucy: I see. How do we get there from the station? Hiroto: Well, let's look at the app. From the station, walk \*toward Lake Wakaba. Turn right at the first corner and walk along the street. You can see the lake on the left. Then, turn left at the corner. You will find the museum on the right. Lucy: I see. Do you know any other places for sightseeing around the museum? Hiroto: Well, how about Wakaba Temple? It is a popular place for foreign people. Lucy: Good. ### **3** 次の英文は、中学生の良(Ryo)が行ったスピーチである。これを読んで、問い (1)~(9) に答えよ。(24点)

I have an uncle, and he lives with his family near the sea. When I visit him with my family, I always swim with him and his son Ken. We have our favorite \*spots in the sea and we can see many beautiful \*corals there. Last year, we swam in one of our favorite spots in summer. However, I was surprised that I didn't see corals. I said to my uncle, "I saw many beautiful corals at the spot two years ago, but I didn't see them today. Why? If you know, please ①[(ア) happened / (イ) what / (ウ) in / (エ) me / (オ) the sea / (カ) tell]." He said, "Well, many corals died last year. The sea became too hot during summer because of the \*extreme weather. Many corals died in other places too, and now many people are ②(try) hard to \*bring back corals to the sea." I said, "【 A 】 I want to know more." He said, "One thing is to \*transplant corals after the sea \*temperature returns to \*normal. Some people transplant corals on a \*tour, and Ken and I sometimes work as a \*guide on the tour during summer. We will do it again next week." I said, "If there is something I can do to bring back corals to the sea, I want to do it." "Then, let's join the tour together," he said, and I decided to join it.

It was sunny on the day of the tour. I visited a small \*building near the sea with my uncle and Ken, and we met some other guides there. We also met other people who joined the tour there, and my uncle said, "Today, we are going to go to two spots. **[ B ]** At those spots, the sea became too hot five years ago and a lot of corals died. However, we transplanted corals three years ago at 3 the first spot on this tour, and now we can see beautiful corals there. At the second spot, we are going to transplant corals." He showed us some small corals and said, "These are the corals we will transplant."

At the first spot, we saw many beautiful corals. **[ C ]** There were many small fish around them. I realized that we can see beautiful corals again and we can also see many fish again if we transplant corals. I didn't imagine <u>©that</u> before the tour. At the second spot, we \*dived into the sea and transplanted the corals. When I finished transplanting the corals and looked at them again, I thought about stars. The corals were like them. I wanted to transplant corals at our favorite spot too and see beautiful corals again in the future.

When I returned to the boat, I said to Ken, "Will the corals we transplanted today die if it becomes too hot in the sea again?" He said, "Yes. However, if we do nothing, we can't bring back corals. When we find problems, we should try to do something. Of course, the most important thing is to protect the environment for them." I said, "I see. **[D]** Is there anything I can do to save corals?" He said, "Yes. Today, extreme weather happens more often because of \*global warming. Also, it is getting hot in the sea because of global warming. If we want to save corals, we have to think about global warming. What can we do to stop it?" I answered, "I think we should not use too much \*electricity." I also said, "We should bring our own bags when we go shopping and we should not use too many plastic bags. Oh, now I understand that I can do many things in my daily life to save corals." Ken said, "I'm glad that you have realized that. We \*emit \*greenhouse gases when we make electricity and other things. So, it is important to think about our actions." I said, "SI'll think more about my actions."

When I swam in our favorite spot last summer, I (6)(feel) sad. I didn't think that corals were dying because of global warming. Now, I think that the same thing may happen to many beautiful things around us, and we may not see those things in the future. We all should realize that and take action. Since last summer, I've changed my actions a little, and I want you to do that too. I'm sure you can save a lot of things around you if you do that.
